Science Activity Lucky Charms Rice Krispy Treats Recipe

What you'll need:

Hands in your lap.

- 1/2 cup unsalted butter
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1 (16 oz) bag mini marshmallows
- 1 (11.5 oz) box Lucky Charms cereal
- 1. Melt butter over low heat in a large pot.
- Once butter has melted, stir in salt and mini marshmallows. Stir constantly until melted.
- 3. Once the marshmallows have melted, remove from heat and stir in cereal. Stir gently so you don't crush the cereal.
- 4. Pour mixture into square pan and GENTLY press. Allow to cool completely before cutting into squares.
