



# Rainforests and Jungles

Rainforests are so important that they are called the "lungs of the Earth". Let's learn more about the rainforest and the jungles with these activities.



Some rain forest creatures are very good at hiding in plain sight. Can you spot the animal in each picture?



#### Read Aloud


