Literacy Activity Winter Item Naming

Pull out winter items from your home and have your child practice saying the names of these items.

As an extension you can also ask them questions like, "Can you find the jacket?"



Math Activity Fruit Loop Lacing

Using a piece of yarn and fruit loops, have your child place the fruit loops on the string.

As an extension, talk about the colors of the fruit loops together.
